Safari Day Camp 2009 Rules

We anticipate that your child/children will have a great time here at Lion Country Safari Day Camp. But, in order for all involved to gain the most from their experience, there are certain rules that all must follow. PLEASE **READ** THESE RULES TOGETHER (PARENT AND CHILD), **SIGN** THE DISCIPLINE PAGE, AND **ENCLOSE** WITH YOUR SAFARI DAY CAMP APPLICATION. **Keep a copy for your records.**

At all times:

- * Respect your fellow campers and counselors - misbehavior by one individual disrupts everyone. Be respectful of other guests at Lion Country Safari, too.
- * Remain quiet and listen when your counselors, directors, or wildlife staff members are talking. They probably have something very important to say.
- * Stay with the group to which you are assigned.

In the bus/van:

- * Stay seated at all times.
- * Keep hands and all objects inside the bus.
- * Talk in a quiet voice so that you may learn more about the animals, and so that you won't frighten them.

In the park:

- * NEVER touch any animal unless you have been given permission to do so at that time.
- * Stay on the sidewalk at all times.
- * Keep your hands and any objects you are carrying out of animal enclosures.
- * WALK so that you won't trip, and talk in a quiet voice.

At the pool area:

- * WALK at all times and treat others the way you would like to be treated.
- * No diving.
- * You may only jump in the deep end feet first and face forward.
- * Always listen to the lifeguard, counselors, and directors. Listen for the whistle.

This list of rules and expectations is intended as a guideline. Other rules not listed here may be enforced. They are in place for the safety of the children, for the safety of the animals, for the safety of our other guests, and so that everyone may experience an enjoyable time with us.

Safari Day Camp Discipline Policy 2009

Safari Day Camp is a safe, fun environment. In order to keep it that way, all campers must abide by the rules. In order to remain at camp, campers must show respect for each other, staff, the animals, and our other guests. Rule violations will be handled in the following manner:

1. Minor Rule Violations (such as talking while a staff member is giving instructions, running instead of walking, cutting in line, etc.)
 - First offense: Verbal warning.
 - Second offense: One-minute time-out.
 - Third offense: Two-minute time-out, and written discipline report will be given to the parent(s) and Camp Director.
 - Fourth offense: Five minutes of lost swimming pool time, and a written discipline report will be given to the parent(s) and Camp Director.
 - Fifth offense: A written discipline report will be given and the Camp Director will be contacted for a conference with the camper. At this time, parent(s) will be contacted by telephone.
 - Sixth offense: A written discipline report will be given and the Camp Director will be contacted for a conference with the camper. At this time, parent(s) will be contacted by telephone to take the camper home early. If the parent(s) or emergency person cannot be contacted using every means available, then the camper will be placed under the direct supervision of the Camp Director until the parents arrive to pick the camper up.
 - Seventh offense: Camper will be dismissed from camp. No refunds will be given.

2. Major Rule Violations involve any aggressive actions taken from one camper toward another, from a camper to a counselor, or blatant disregard of the rules by a camper. These violations include: wandering off from the group; aggressive physical contact (pushing, shoving, hitting, fighting); verbal abuse (cursing, taunting, teasing, lying, etc.); and touching or feeding animals without permission, or entering an animal enclosure without permission. These violations are considered severe enough to warrant immediate dismissal from camp, and will be dealt with as follows:
 - First offense: A written discipline report will be given and the Camp Director will be contacted for a conference with the camper. At this time, parent(s) will be contacted by telephone. Depending upon the severity of the offense, the parents may also be asked to pick up the camper immediately, and the camper may be dismissed from camp. No refunds. If a second chance seems appropriate, it may be granted, but the camper must be aware of his/her actions, apologize to all parties involved, and change behavior.
 - Second offense: Camper will be dismissed from camp. No refunds will be given.
