How to Register by mail, fax, or in person:

1. **Complete all 4 pages of the application. Be sure to sign and date the last page. Applications will not be accepted without parent signature and date.**
2. Complete both sides and sign the **Safari Day Camp Health Card**, including information about inoculations and allergies. **One for each camper. We must receive this before camp starts!**
3. Read the rules together with the camper(s). Both parent and camper(s) must **sign and return the Discipline Policy** with the application. Keep a copy for your records.
4. Refer to page 3 of the application for fee. Enclose payment (check, money order, or credit card information) with registration materials. **Payment is due in full for all sessions registered.**

6. *Applications will not be accepted by phone, nor can we "hold spots" by phone.*
7. Camper will only be enrolled when all registration materials (application, rules, health card, and payment) are received and if space is available. You will receive a confirmation email if your camper is enrolled. If the session you are requesting is filled, we will contact you to arrange for an alternate session. If all sessions are full, your name will be placed on the waiting list and your application materials will be returned to you.

Registration fee/Refund policy

1. Camp sessions are filled on a first-enrolled, first-served basis. **Enrollment is limited, so please register early** (see #7 above for enrollment policy).
2. A **non-refundable fee of \$50 per camper is held if camper withdraws prior to 2 weeks before session(s) camper is enrolled. Cancellations after this will be given no refunds.**
3. Registration is subject to availability, but all enrollments or cancellations must be transacted at least 2 weeks prior to camp session chosen. Cancellations after this will be given no refunds.
4. Camp sessions run, rain or shine. **No refunds will be given for inclement weather or camper absence.**
5. Payment must be made in full with registration. Your child (ren) will *only* be enrolled for the session(s) which are paid for when application is submitted.
6. *Each camper receives only 1 T-shirt, 1 water bottle, and 1 cap no matter how many weeks of camp he or she has registered for.* Additional supplies are available for \$10.00 each with registration. Very few (if any) extra supplies are available once camp begins.
7. Any requests for changes (switching a week, etc.) must be made in writing in advance. Email education@LionCountrySafari.com. Accommodations can only be made if space is available. **NO CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE UNLESS YOU HAVE RECEIVED A WRITTEN CONFIRMATION SHOWING THAT THE CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE.**

Group Rate: If you are part of a group of 5 or more campers registering *at the same time* (for any number of weeks), please write your group's name at the top of Page 1 of this application. You will receive the special group rate of \$170 per week, per camper. All 5 or more must sign up within 1 week of each other. No other discounts apply except the \$10 per week early registration, which ends on **March 31, 2012.** Special offer is subject to availability. Register early! **Group rate ends May 31, 2012** (or earlier, if camp is full). All campers in the group must meet requirements for Safari Day Camp eligibility. Note: Due to space availability, we cannot guarantee that all campers will be placed together, even if they are the same age. However, best efforts will be made to accommodate placement requests. Each family in the group must complete its own application and list the same group name in order to qualify as a group. For instance, if Mrs. Smith enrolls her family of 3 campers, and her friend Mrs. Jones registers her family of 2 campers, they both write the same group name (of their choosing) at the top of page 1 of each application to get the Group Rate. Note: Group name may not contain the name of a school. **No refunds will be given for cancellation at group rate.**

Safari Day Camp 2012 Rules

We anticipate that your child/children will have a great time at Lion Country Safari Day Camp. But, in order for all involved to gain the most from the experience, there are certain rules that all must follow. **PLEASE READ THESE RULES TOGETHER (PARENT AND CHILD), SIGN THE DISCIPLINE PAGE, AND ENCLOSE WITH YOUR SAFARI DAY CAMP APPLICATION. Keep a copy for your records.**

At all times:

- * Respect your fellow campers and counselors - misbehavior by one individual disrupts everyone. Be respectful of other guests at Lion Country Safari, too.
- * Remain quiet and listen when your counselors, directors, or staff members are talking. They probably have something very important to say.
- * Stay with the group to which you are assigned.

In the bus/van:

- * Stay seated at all times.
- * Keep hands and all objects inside the bus.
- * Talk in a quiet voice so that you may learn more about the animals, and so that you won't frighten them.

In the park:

- * NEVER touch any animal unless you have been given permission to do so at that time.
- * Stay on the sidewalk at all times.
- * Keep your hands and any objects you are carrying out of animal enclosures.
- * WALK so that you won't trip, and talk in a quiet voice.

At the pool area:

- * WALK at all times and treat others the way you would like to be treated.
- * No diving.
- * You may only jump in the deep end feet-first and face-forward.
- * Always listen to the lifeguard, counselors, and directors. Listen for the whistle.

This list of rules and expectations is intended as a guideline. Other rules not listed here may also be enforced. They are in place for the safety of the children, for the safety of the animals, for the safety of our other guests, and so that everyone may experience an enjoyable time with us.

Safari Day Camp Discipline Policy 2012

Safari Day Camp is a safe, fun environment. In order to keep it that way, all campers must abide by the rules. In order to remain at camp, campers must show respect for each other, staff, the animals, and our other guests. Rule violations will be handled in the following manner:

1. Minor Rule Violations (such as talking while a staff member is giving instructions, running instead of walking, cutting in line, etc.)
 - First offense: Verbal warning.
 - Second offense: One-minute time-out.
 - Third offense: Two-minute time-out, and written discipline report will be given to the parent(s) and Camp Director.
 - Fourth offense: Five minutes of lost swimming pool time, and a written discipline report will be given to the parent(s) and Camp Director.
 - Fifth offense: A written discipline report will be given and the Camp Director will be contacted for a conference with the camper. At this time, parent(s) will be contacted by telephone.
 - Sixth offense: A written discipline report will be given and the Camp Director will be contacted for a conference with the camper. At this time, parent(s) will be contacted by telephone to take the camper home early. If the parent(s) or emergency person cannot be contacted using every means available, then the camper will be placed under the direct supervision of the Camp Director until the parents arrive to pick the camper up.
 - Seventh offense: Camper will be dismissed from camp. No refunds will be given.

2. Major Rule Violations involve any aggressive actions taken from one camper toward another, from a camper to a counselor, or blatant disregard of the rules by a camper. These violations include: wandering off from the group; aggressive physical contact (pushing, shoving, hitting, fighting); verbal abuse (cursing, taunting, teasing, lying, etc.); and touching or feeding animals without permission, or entering an animal enclosure without permission. These violations are considered severe enough to warrant immediate dismissal from camp, and will be dealt with as follows:
 - First offense: A written discipline report will be given and the Camp Director will be contacted for a conference with the camper. At this time, parent(s) will be contacted by telephone. Depending upon the severity of the offense, the parents may also be asked to pick up the camper immediately, and the camper may be dismissed from camp. No refunds. If a second chance seems appropriate, it may be granted, but the camper must be aware of his/her actions, apologize to all parties involved, and change behavior.
 - Second offense: Camper will be dismissed from camp. No refunds will be given.
