



## Important Information for Group Leaders!

Your Safari Adventure begins as you drive through our 320-acre wildlife preserve, home to hundreds of magnificent animals from around the world. While they roam freely, YOU will be contained within your vehicle in THEIR territory. **Just remember, our animals always have the right-of-way!**

Park your vehicle and continue the fun in Safari World, the walk-through portion of your adventure. There are many more animal exhibits for you to enjoy. You can ride the zoo carousel or Ferris Wheel, visit the Petting Zoo, play mini-golf, interact with our lory birds, feed the giraffe, attend the flamingo talk, parrot talk, or alligator chit-chat, take a narrated cruise on the Safari Queen, or use your own pedal power on our paddle boats. The flying elephant ride, maze, toddler train ride, and daily educational animal presentations in our Animal Theater are also provided at no additional charge.

**Animals + children = FIELD TRIP FUN! But safety must come first.**

To ensure that your visit to Lion Country Safari is exciting, educational and safe, please have your group follow these guidelines to make your visit more enjoyable for all.

### LION COUNTRY SAFARI RULES

1. While in the 4-mile drive through preserve, doors and windows must be closed at ALL times.
2. Please have one (1) adult chaperone for every ten (10) children.
3. **Chaperones MUST remain with their groups at all times, at all locations. Unaccompanied children will NOT be permitted in the gift shops, restaurant, petting zoo, or in any of the entertainment areas.**
4. If your group is larger than 30, please divide it into smaller groups with appropriate chaperones.
5. If you plan to bring your own lunches, please enjoy them in the covered picnic tables to the right of the waterfall at the entrance of Safari World. Restaurant seating is reserved for restaurant customers only! The large pavilion near the preserve exit gate is reserved for a rental fee and used for large private events only.
6. If your group is arriving in cars rather than buses, please place a dashboard sign with your group's name in each of your vehicles prior to arriving.
7. **The group leader should be in the first car or bus and know the exact number of guests and have payment ready for the entire group.**
8. DO NOT touch or feed any of the animals, except at the petting zoo, lories, or giraffe feeding.
9. DO NOT run or shout, since it stresses the animals.
10. DO NOT tease the animals. Like people, animals do not like to be teased.
11. DO NOT LITTER! Please dispose of all trash appropriately.
12. **Due to space limitations in the Safari Splash Water park, large groups will be divided into smaller groups and scheduled for ONE 30 minute session each. The Splash area will be closed and unavailable for inclement weather or any other unsafe conditions. No rain checks are given.** Bathing suits are required, and we recommend bringing towels and sunscreen.
