



## **Scout Badge Program Workshop**

### **CADETTE Girl Scout: Naturalist: Trees**

**Note:** *Lion Country Safari's badge workshop will help your Scout group prepare for earning a badge. The following list will help you to understand what Lion Country Safari covers in this workshop. This workshop will cover some, not all, of the requirements and we do not provide the patches for the workshop. All badge workshops must be arranged in advance and are subject to availability.*

- Step Two
  - Be a naturalist in your neighborhood: we will go over some local trees and see if they are native or imported. Also uses that both people and wildlife have for it.
  - Sketch and label parts of a tree: scouts will sketch a tree and label the parts
  - Delve into the forest life cycle: we briefly cover how a fire can benefit a forest.
- Step Three
  - Get tree crafty: we will be making a craft using part of a seed pod from a tree.
- Step Four
  - Debate logging, clear-cutting, and deforestation: we touch on some of the pros and cons associated with logging, and some possible ideas to lessen impact felt from logging.
- Step Five
  - Plant a tree: we go over the steps for starting a tree from a seed and will provide seeds that can be planted as a troop later.
- Learn some actions you can take to protect our natural resources.
