



## **Scout Badge Program Workshop**

### **WEBELOS ELECTIVE ADVENTURE: Into the Wild**

**Note:** *Lion Country Safari's badge workshop will help your Scout group prepare for earning a badge. The following list will help you to understand what Lion Country Safari covers, and what the Scout and/or group will need to do to complete the badge requirements. All badge workshops must be arranged in advance.*

Completed at Lion Country Safari:

1. Learn about the bird flyways closest to your home. Find out which birds use these flyways.
2. Watch at least four wild creatures (reptiles, amphibians, arachnids, fish, insects, or mammals) in the wild. Describe the kind of place (forest, field, marsh, yard, or park) where you saw them. Tell what they were doing.
3. Identify an insect, reptile, bird, or other wild animal that is found only in your area of the country. Tell why it survives in your area.
4. Give examples of:
  - a. One way humans have changed the balance of nature
  - b. How you can help protect the balance of nature
5. Learn about aquatic ecosystems and wetlands in your area. Talk with your Webelos den leader or family about the important role aquatic ecosystems and wetlands play in supporting life cycles of wildlife and humans, and list three ways you can help.
6. Visit a museum of natural history, a nature center, or a zoo with your family, Webelos den, or pack. Tell what you saw.
